Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC)



The WSCC model focuses its attention on the child, emphasizes a school-wide approach, and acknowledges learning, health and the school as being a part and reflection of the local community. By focusing on youth, addressing critical education and health outcomes, organizing collaborative actions and initiatives that support students, and strongly engaging community resources, the WSCC approach offers important opportunities that may improve healthy development and educational attainment for students.
